

The Denver Fire Department Is Pleased to Announce a Spring 2020 Lateral Academy

At the time of application, an applicant must be currently employed as a full-time paid firefighter employed by a state, county, or municipal fire department;

or be a retired firefighter who voluntarily separated (within the last 12 months) from full time paid employment from a state, county, or municipal fire department;

or be a former paid firefighter who was separated (within the last 12 months) as a result of a lay-off from full time employment by a state, county, or municipal fire department;

with a minimum of three consecutive years (full-time) paid firefighting experience while employed full time by a state, county, or municipal fire department.

At the time of application, applicants must also possess and provide copies of the following current certifications/accreditations:

- ◆ State Firefighter II certification (must meet ProBoard/IFSAC accreditation);
- ◆ Hazardous Materials Operations certification (must meet ProBoard/IFSAC accreditation);
- ◆ National Registry Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) certification; and
- ◆ CPR certification (must meet Healthcare Provider or Professional Rescuer qualification).

At time of appointment, applicants must possess and provide a current copy of the following:

- ◆ Candidate Physical Ability Test (CPAT) certification.

Per the International Association of Fire Fighters (IAFF), CPAT certifications are only valid for a twelve-month period from date of issuance.

- Application period will open 9am MST on Monday August 26, 2019 until all spots are filled
- Only 100 applications will be accepted
- Testing is scheduled to be on September 16 & 17, 2019
